Card Measurements are in inches

1. Card Base 5" x 11" Basic White cardstock scored and fold at 7"
2. Gates 3½" x 3" Basic White cardstock (Need 2) Scored ½" down 3" side
3. Top Layer 4¾" x 3¾" Daffodil Delight cardstock
4. Next Top Layer 4½" x 3½" Basic White cardstock
5. Gates next layer 2¼" x 3¼" Daffodil Delight (need 2)
6. Gates next layer 2" x 3" Basic White cardstock (need 2)
7. Insider Layers 4¾" x 6¾" Daffodil Delight cardstock and 6½" x 4½" Basic White cardstock
8. ¼ sheet of Basic White cardstock for stamping and Die Cutting.

Card Instructions:

1. Using the Hive 3D Emboss folder, emboss the 4½" x 3½" Basic White top layer - and the 2" x 3" Basic White 2 gate layers. Then sponge lightly using the Daffodil Delight ink and the Blending Brush (see image)
2. Punch out corners of the top of the base card and the two top layers (see cards) the adhere the two top layers to the base (see image)
3. Adhere the two 3½" x 3" Basic White gates to each side of the bottom of the base card to form the gate. Making sure it is adhere on the inside, not the outside. Then adhere the other two layers to the gates (see image)
4. On the ¼ sheet of Basic White cardstock stamp the image of the Bee and Sprig of flowers images and the greeting using Early Espresso ink. Also stamp three little flowers.

Continue over

5. Using the Stampin' Blends colour the stamped Bee and the sprig of flowers
 - For the Bee and flowers use Granny Apple Green for the leaves and Daffodil Delight for the flowers. For Heart use Real Red.
6. Die cut the images using the matching Bee and Sprig Dies from the Queen Bee Dies, Die cut the greeting using the second smallest frame from the Stitch So Sweetly Dies
7. Die cut a scrap of Daffodil Delight cardstock using the second smallest Die from the Stitched So Sweetly Dies.
8. Attach the greeting onto the Daffodil Delight Die cut piece, off centre the top layer (see image)
9. Attach the Bee, Sprig of flowers and the little flowers to the top of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals (see image)
10. Attach the greeting only to the left side of the gate. Attach the little bee trinket to the top of the greeting (see image)

Insert:

1. On the bottom half of the 6½" x 4½" Basic White cardstock stamp the Bee image and colour the Bee as same other Bee image.
2. Then attach to the 4¾" x 6¾" Daffodil Delight insert. Then attach to the inside of the card.
